

Directions to West Park Dog Show - 2010

Please note – a sports stadium - the ‘KC Stadium’ has been built within West Park and so the Brown Road Signs to the KC Stadium provide routes from certain directions.

From WEST:

Along M62 and A63 towards Hull. Ignore turnings to Humber Bridge. Continue along A63 (Clive Sullivan Way) and pass underneath the Humber Bridge itself. Continue on the A63 for exactly 4 miles from passing under the bridge. Ignoring the first 2 exits and take the 3rd exit at exactly 4 miles, which is just after you enter a 40 MPH zone and signposted Infirmery (DO NOT go over the flyover). You will now come to a roundabout. Take the 2nd exit, which is virtually opposite you and is signposted Anlaby and the Infirmery. Continue along this road (Rawling Way) for 0.4 of a mile to the first junction which is crossroads controlled by traffic lights. Turn left, signposted Anlaby. Continue along Anlaby Road for 0.5 of a mile and over the railway flyover, and turn right at the traffic lights at the bottom of the flyover, into Walton Street. Drive along Walton Street for 0.2 of a mile, the entrance to West Park is on the right. Enter the park gates.

From EAST:

Drive through Hull on the A63, following signs for the M62. Look for signs for the Infirmery immediately before (but DO NOT go over) the large flyover near Smith & Nephew. (If you come out of the 40 MPH limit into the national limit you have gone too far). Take the exit to the Infirmery and at the roundabout underneath the flyover take the 3rd exit, signposted Anlaby and the Infirmery. You are now on Rawling Way. Continue along this road (Rawling Way) for 0.4 of a mile to the first junction which is crossroads controlled by traffic lights. Turn left, signposted Anlaby. Continue along Anlaby Road for 0.5 of a mile and over the railway flyover, and turn right at the traffic lights at the bottom of the flyover, into Walton Street. Drive along Walton Street for 0.2 of a mile, the entrance to West Park is on the right. Enter the park gates.

Once Inside West Park:

Due to major alterations expected with the Park in the next few years, it is uncertain where cars can go at the moment. Directions within the Park will be signposted. It is expected that parking will still be around the showground. Please ensure you arrive at the Park before 11am, as at that time (if a match is scheduled for that day) the Park gates will be locked.

Overnight parking NOT advisable.
